- d. After students encountered UHS tabling events about nicotine / tobacco, did students share how tabling affected them?
 - i. A lot of the reflections are around what situations students face on campus that encourage student use of tobacco or nicotine and what situations and resources give students empowerment to stop. We give away the quitting resources. The tabling gives space for students to share.
- e. Thomas – Is UHS actively working with state policy or federal policy?
 - i. There is UW – System wide collaboration with other Universities in Wisconsin. Dane County Public Health has helped / partnered with us.
- f. Does the current policy apply to outdoor sports facilities? Stadium, soccer field, etc.
 - i. Yes
- g. What would it look like if a student broke the policy?
 - i. We train staff, faculty, & students. Politely ask - “Did you know that we have a tobacco free policy?” Give out a map of where they can go to use nicotine / tobacco.
 - ii. Jake has previously led this at another campus and had to help people through enforcement. A lot of prep work goes into it. There are processes in place for policy violations. You can work within those existing systems.
- h. Roberta – UW System schools – has there been a discussion about elected officials to work on a bill for consideration of statute across the system?
 - i. We are unaware if there is anything at that level – we are not aware of the state legislative level.
- i. Naureen – Systems review of other big 10 schools – what was successful cessation in the other big 10s?
 - i. At a previous institution – “quit coach.” UHS could look at doing

this. "Quit lines" are another option.
